I. Introduction

 - 1. God recognizes a special group of believers—those who are in love with Christ's appearing.
 - **2.** There is a *special honor* for these special believers—a crown of righteousness.
 - 3. Do you qualify for that special honor?
- **B.** Titus 2:11–13
 - 1. Grace teaches us how we should live.
 - 2. The motivation for the *way* we live is the anticipation of the coming of the Lord
 - **3.** Most of the appeals to holy living in the New Testament are related to the anticipation of the Lord's return.

- **A.** Consummation of our salvation: Transformation of our physical body
 - 1. Phil. 3:8–12, 20–21
 - **a.** Unite your purpose with Christ's purpose for your life.
 - **b.** This body of humiliation will be transformed into a body of glory.
 - **2.** Col. 3:3–4

We will appear with Him in glory

3. John 6:39–40, 44, 54

The result of faith in Christ is resurrection

- **B.** Consummation of our union
 - **1.** With *Christ* (Rev. 19:6–7)
 - **2.** With each other (1 Thess. 4:16–18)
- C. Only hope for suffering humanity
 - 1. Christ's kingdom will banish *all* results of evil and vindicate the suffering and oppressed (Ps. 72:1–14, 102:16–17)
 - 2. Sudden, overwhelming intervention (Dan. 2:31–35, 44)
 - 3. Do not be caught unprepared (1 Thess. 5:2–4)
- **D.** Redemption of creation
 - 1. Romans 8:18–23
 - **2.** Psalm 96:11–13
 - **3.** Psalm 98:7–9
